#### ORDER OF BUSINESS

Any item of interest that is within the jurisdiction of Ebbet's Pass Veteran's Memorial District and is not posted on the Regular agenda may be addressed during the Public Comment period. California law prohibits the District from taking action on any matter which is not posted on the agenda unless it is determined to be an emergency by the District. The Public Comment period shall not exceed a total of 15 minutes. If Public Comment is completed before the end of the 15 minute allotted time period, the Board may immediately move to the Regular Agenda. Each speaker is to limit their remarks to no more than 5 minutes unless further time is granted by the Chairperson.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Designate a board member to act as the sole communicator with County Counsel.

Authority is hereby delegated to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (the "Delegated Officer") to request and receive legal opinions from the County Counsel's Office of Calaveras County. Notwithstanding this delegation of authority, the Delegated Officer shall keep the Board apprised of any legal matter involving any issues that have the potential for unusual attention or publicity or the potential for significant liability. The Delegated Officer shall have no authority of redelegation.
